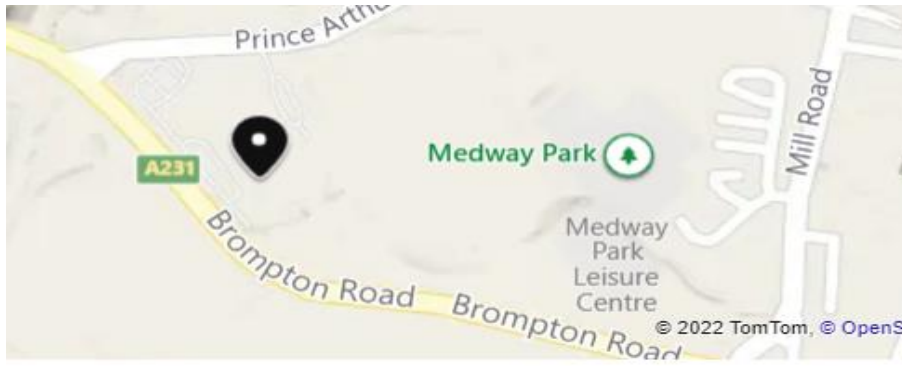

General Rules	<p>BJA contest rules will be operative throughout the event; all other regulations regarding the event will be in accordance with the BJA Tournament Handbook.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medallists must wear judogi during the medal presentations. Medals will only be presented when each group is presented. • Competitors are expected to provide their own blue and white competition belts. • Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when off the mat. • Point Scoring — Seniors and Youth where appropriate. • The 'Golden Score' will operate throughout the event. Any rules incorporated after the issue of this entry form will also apply • Compound knockout will be in use throughout the event, however if a group has seven or less players a pools system will be used. • If there are insufficient entries in a weight group the organiser reserves the right to combine weight groups after consultation with appropriate competitors.
